To amend title XVIII of the Social Security Act to provide for the treatment of certain hospitals as critical access hospitals under the Medicare program.

- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Rural Hospital Fair-

4	Section 1820(h) of the Social Security Act (42 U.S.C.
5	1395i-4(h)) is amended by adding at the end the following

9	"(A) IN GENERAL.—A facility described in
