I am requesting funding for the E Street and Westgate Water Improvement Program in Fiscal Year 2026. The entity to receive this funding is the City of Williams located at 810 E Street, Williams, California 95987. The funding would be used for replacing 6,800 feet of deficient, severely corroded, and leaking pipelines, services, and meters in the community. This project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because it supports upgrading the current water system so it can be pressurized to a higher level to meet firefighting needs and reduce leakage. The project has a federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized by Section 1452 of the Safe Drinking Water Act (Public Law 108-182).
